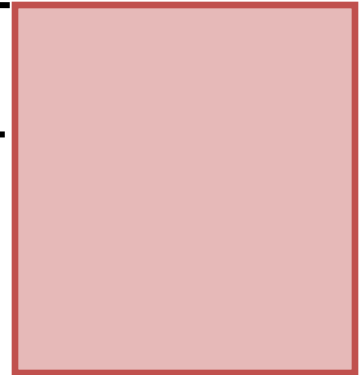

YMCA of Southern Arizona Mandatory Automatic Transfer System (ATS) Agreement

I understand that the information below will be used to transfer payment from my account on the agreed upon schedule. **All payments are on the bank draft system attached to your debit or credit card account. Payments will be withdrawn weekly on the noted draft dates. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.** You are reserving a space for your child. Your deposit and reserve space will be forfeited if the payment does not clear your account. If your payment is returned NSF for any reason, the items will be re-presented electronically and you will be charged a \$25 processing fee.

Child Admission and Release Requirements

- You must sign a separate sign in/sign out record for each of your children.
- You must write in the exact time of day that you sign your child in. DO NOT ROUND OFF TIMES.
- You must write in the exact time of day that you sign your child out-do not fill in the time or sign out until after care has been provided.
- Use ink (NOT pencil) and sign your own first initial and last name on each day of care. This shows that you agree that the times in and out are true and accurate.
- Do NOT use ditto marks or arrows in place of actual times or your signature.
- If you authorize someone else to sign your child in and out the authorization must be in writing and on file with the child care provider; and the authorized person must be at least 18 years of age.
- Signers will be required to show proof of identification to staff. An ID with picture and signature, such as a driver's license, will be required.
- Please note that the 'day' column refers to the calendar day of the month. Sign your child in and out using that format.
- Failure to sign a child in or out may result in additional fees.
